### **Swimming Pool & Pool Area Rules**

0. There is no life guard on duty.
1. The pool is for the exclusive use of residents and their guests and residents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their guests.
2. Swimming is permitted during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. only.
3. All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult resident, and supervised at all times by the adult resident.
4. All residents and their guests are required to wear their pool pins or wrist bands when in the pool area to identify their authorized use of the pool.
5. No person may enter the pool area in an intoxicated condition.
6. Each resident family may bring up to two (2) guests to the pool. All guests must be accompanied and supervised by an adult resident at all times.
7. The pool furniture is not to be removed from the pool area. Furniture other than that provided, is not to be brought into the pool area.
8. The pool may not be reserved for private parties.
9. Shoes or sandals are to be worn while walking to the pool, so that only clean feet enter the pool.
10. Any person having a skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharges, open wounds, or any communicable disease shall be excluded from the pool.
11. Showers are required before entering the pool. No tanning oil is allowed in the pool (it collects filth and gums up the filtering system).
12. Residents are responsible for cleaning their tanning oil off the pool furniture when they leave the pool area so others don't get it all over their clothes.
13. No running, pushing, scuffling, splashing or rough play is permitted in the pool area.

14. Glass containers of any kind are prohibited in the pool area.
15. Food and drinks must be kept at least eight (8) feet away from the pool.
16. Swimming suits only in the pool. No cut-offs, tee-shirts, or street clothing. Babies must wear a snug diaper, rubber pants, AND a swim suit.
17. Voices shall be kept at normal conversation levels.
18. Radios, television sets, tape-recording or tape-playing devices, and all other similar devices are strictly forbidden in the pool area.
19. The gates to the pool area are to remain closed and locked at all times, and are not to be propped open or otherwise left unsecured.
20. Do not open the pool gates to let in unsupervised children or guests.
21. All bobby pins, hair pins and other such items that can clog the filtering system are to be removed before entering the pool.
22. Objects such as frisbies, volleyballs, and the like are not allowed in the pool area. Feather-weight objects such as nerf balls or beach balls may be used with discretion.
23. Only rubber coated sinking devices may be used for diving games. No rocks or metal objects are to be thrown in to be dived for, because such items can damage the bottom of the pool.
24. Users of the pool area are responsible for removing all articles they bring to the pool (including towels, books, magazines, beach balls, etc.) at the time they leave the area.
25. Balconies are not to be used as clothes lines for drying out towels and swim wear.
26. Failure to comply with these regulations will be grounds for the exclusion of a resident or guest from the pool area.
27. Residents must read, sign and return one copy of these regulations to the Office before entering the pool.
